- Enclosed is the tournament schedule, rules & regulations, additional info, a score sheet & parent permission form.
- **PLEASE** fill in your player names and numbers on the enclosed score sheet and make 4 copies. These score sheets must be brought with you on the tournament date and presented to the scorekeepers table before each game.
- Games will be played in the High School gym (two courts), Middle School gym (one court).
- Please enter through the Pequot Lakes High School (south) doors. Admission is \$3.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students. Team players, coaches and Pre-school aged children are free.
- Concessions with food, snacks and beverages will be available.
- Please bring your own practice balls.
- There will not be locker rooms available – please come dressed and ready to play.
- Players are responsible for their own valuables; please do not bring items not needed.
- A scorekeeper and timer will be provided. If by chance they are not available, we will ask someone from your team to help out.
- Please be positive in your actions and words. Parents, players and coaches should be positive in all situations. Sportsmanship is a must.
- It is impossible to officiate without missing some calls. So if it does happen, please show understanding towards the refs, they are doing their best.
- **Most of all have fun, and enjoy the day!**

## RULES & REGULATIONS

- Games will consist of 2 – 18 minute halves - running time. The clock will stop the last 2 minutes of each half. There will be a three-minute halftime.
- The game ball will be provided – official women's size.
- Four 1-minute time outs per team per game. Coaches and players may call time outs.
- First overtime will be 2-minutes – stop time. Second overtime will be 2-minutes – stop time. One 1-minute time out per team per overtime. No carry-overs.
- The clock will stop for all time-outs, injuries and at the official's discretion.
- Half court defense only. Man to man. No half court traps or double-teaming. No zone defense. In the last two minutes of the game, pressing is allowed except when the lead is 15 points or greater.
- Fouls will be kept and the 5<sup>th</sup> foul rule will be enforced.
- A technical will not be shot. Two points and the ball will be awarded.
- Free throws will be on shooting fouls, 1 & 1 on the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul & two shots on the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul per half. After the 15<sup>th</sup> team foul in the half the fouled team will shoot two shots and retain possession of the ball.
- 3 seconds lane violation will be called.
- If you are playing round robin play, the following will determine the lead team...
  - \* win – loss record
  - \* head to head competition, then,
  - \* fewest points given up
- Coaches can make substitutions during the usual dead ball situations (out of bounds, violations, free throws or time-outs). Please have the subs check-in at the score keeper's desk. Player may enter the game only when the referee signals the player to enter.
- With a tight schedule, there may not be much time between games. Please stretch out in the halls or commons area. A 5-minute warm-up will be allowed. Be ready to play at the assigned time.
- The first team listed and/or the top team in the bracket will be the home team.
- The scoreboard is the official score. Any questions on the score must be discussed at the moment of question. Questions from fans must go through the coaches of the players. The referees and scorekeepers will make the final call.
- All referees decisions are final.
